What is the Asthma Home Walkthrough Program?

A free program offered by the West Allis Health Department in which a Public Health Professional will walk through your home with you to identify issues in your home environment that may be contributing to your asthma problems. The Public Health Professional will then give you recommendations on how to make changes to your home to help improve your asthma control.

Who can sign up?

Residents of West Allis/West Milwaukee that have asthma or have a family member in the home with asthma.

How long does the walkthrough take?

The walkthrough takes about an hour to complete depending on the size of your home.

How do I sign up?

Contact WIC or your West Allis/West Milwaukee School District Nurse for a referral.

How much does it cost?

This program is offered for FREE to residents of West Allis/West Milwaukee.

What will I gain by participating?

Informational packet on asthma triggers and ways to rid them from your home, better asthma control and a healthier home!
